## **God made water & fish! (January/July)**

**Supplies:** Bible; water mats with fish (place water mats around the table for children to share)

**Song:** "My God is so Big" by Studio Musicians (play song during snack)

### Lesson:

- Look what God made! He made the water.
- Can you touch the water and make it move? Allow children to push on the water mats.
- In my Bible (show Bible), we learn that God made water.
- God also made fish to swim in the water. Can you see fish in our water? Have children point to the fish.
- In my Bible (show Bible), we learn that God made different colored fish. Refer to the different colored fish that are floating in the water mats.
- Let's clap and thank God for making fish and water!

(Lesson based on Genesis 1:1 and 1:20)



# **God made me! (February/August)**

Supplies: Bible; hand mirrors (give each child a mirror)

Song: "I Am Special" by Jacquelyn Negus and Jon Negus (play song during snack)

#### Lesson:

- God made you!
- God made boys (point to the boys), and God made girls (point to the girls).
- God made your eyes to see (point to your own eyes). Can you point to your eyes? Have children look in the mirror and point to their eyes. God gave you eyes to see all the beautiful things He created.
- God made your ears to hear (point to your own ears). Where are your ears? Have children look in the mirror and point to their ears. God gave you ears to hear.
- In my Bible (show Bible), we learn that God made you!
- Let's clap and worship God for making you!
- Thank You, God, for making me.

(Lesson based on Genesis 1:27)





# **God made food! (March/September)**

**Supplies:** Bible; plastic fruit - apples, bananas, and oranges (give each child a piece of fruit)

**Song:** "God is Good to Me" by Little Praise Party (play song during snack)


### Lesson:

- Look what God made! He made food.
- Who has a red apple? Highlight the red apples.
- God made apples.
- Who has an orange? Highlight the oranges.
- God made oranges.
- Who has a yellow banana? Highlight the bananas.
- God made bananas.
- In my Bible (show Bible), we learn that God made all food!
- Let's clap and thank God for making food.









# **God made music! (April/October)**



**Supplies:** Bible; music shakers or instruments (give each child an instrument)

**Song:** "Jesus Love Me" (disco version) by Listener Kids

### Lesson:

- Play song while children shake the instruments and praise Jesus.
- We can praise and sing to God because He loves us so much.
- In my Bible (show Bible), there is a verse about singing to God, "From the lips of children and infants you have ordained praise..." Psalm 8:2
- This means we can use our music to praise God.
- Let's clap and thank God for music!





### **God made animals! (May/November)**

**Supplies:** Bible; plastic animals (give each child an animal)

**Song:** "Thank You, Lord, for Making Me" by Willow Creek Music (*play song at the end of the lesson and during snack*)

### Lesson:

- God made the animals! Let's look at all the animals God made.
- Wow, each animal has a name. We have elephants, cows, horses, sheep, etc. Name each animal depending on your animal resources.
- What sound does each animal make? Make the sound of each animal with the children.
- God made the animals. In my Bible (show Bible), we learn that God made all the animals. He made BIG animals, like elephants, and small animals, like rabbits.
- Let's clap and thank God for all the animals.
- Have children look at the animals as you play the song.











### **God made babies! (June/December)**

Supplies: Bible; baby dolls (give each child a baby doll)

**Songs:** "Jesus Loves Me" by Listener Kids and "I Am Special" by Jacquelyn Negus and Jon Negus (play songs during snack)

#### Lesson:

- God made babies.
- My baby has eyes (point to the eyes). Does your baby have eyes? Have children point to the eyes. God gave us eyes.
- My baby has a nose (point to the nose). Does your baby have a nose? Have children point to the nose. God gave us a nose.
- If time, repeat with ears and mouth.
- In my Bible (show Bible), we learn that God made all babies, and He made them very special!
- Let's hug our babies.
- Thank You, God, for making babies.

(Lesson based on Psalm 139:13-16)





## Jesus is born! (Special Christmas Lesson)

**Supplies:** Bible; child-safe nativity set (like Fisher-Price)

**Song:** "Away in a Manger" and "Joy to the World" (play song during snack)

### Lesson:

- In the Bible, we can learn about the day Jesus was born.
- Can you see a baby? Show baby Jesus.
- Baby Jesus had a mom and dad. They were named Mary and Joseph. *Place Mary and Joseph by Jesus*.
- When Jesus was a baby, many people came to see Him. These people walked a long way to see Jesus. Walk the Shepherd and Wise Men across the table to baby Jesus.
- When they saw baby Jesus, they were very happy to see Him! Have children clap.

(Lesson based on Luke 2:1-16)





## Jesus is alive! (Special Easter Lesson)

**Supplies:** Donkey, palm branches (one for each child), cross, angel, empty tomb **Song:** "Hosanna Rock" by Yancy & Little Praise Party (*play song during snack*)



### Lesson:

- Here comes Jesus riding on a donkey. Have the donkey walk past the children.
- The people shouted "Hosanna!" and waved palm branches because Jesus is very important. Have children wave the palm branches and the donkey and Jesus walk past them.
- But something happened; people became angry and mean. They took Jesus and put Him on a cross, and He died.
- They put his body in a tomb. But three days later He rose again!
- Jesus is alive! Have children clap and wave their palm branches.

(Lesson based on John 12:12-15, 1 Corinthians 15:3-4)
