Lesson Review Questions

Year 3 – Quarter 2

Leader's Note: Reword questions to better suit the developmental age level of the students you're working with or to better fit the game/activity. They can be revised to be multiple choice, true or false, or fill in the blank. The purpose of the review questions is to reinforce what students have learned, not to stump students. Incorrect answers should always be kindly and positively corrected, so all students clearly hear the correct answer. *Note: Lesson Review Cards are available in the appendix.*

Lesson 1

1. Why did God allow 400 years of silence? (To prepare the world for Jesus)
2. Did God change during this time? (No)
3. What are some things that did change during this time? (There were new leaders and a new language put in place, roads were built, there were no prophets speaking, etc.)
4. Did all the people continue to believe in the one true God? (No)
5. Will God always keep His promises? (Yes)

Lesson 2

1. What did John the Baptist look like on the outside? (He wore camel's hair clothes with a leather belt, and he ate locusts and wild honey)
2. How would you describe John the Baptist on the inside? (He loved God and confidently served Him)
3. What did God send John the Baptist to do? (God sent John to help people get ready for Jesus)
4. What did John say to the people he was helping get ready for Jesus? (He told them to listen to Jesus and obey Him)
5. Was John the Baptist confident or wimpy? (He was confident)
6. How was John the Baptist confident? (He told people the Savior, Jesus, was coming and that Jesus was the important one)
7. What does God want you to be? (A confident servant who tells people about Jesus)
8. Can you think of some ways you can be God's servant this Christmas season?

Lesson 3

1. Who was Jesus' mother? (Mary)
2. Who was Jesus' real Father? (God)
3. Where was Jesus born? (Bethlehem)
4. Why did God send Jesus as a gift to this earth? (To be our Savior)
5. Recite Acts 16:31.
6. Have you trusted in Jesus to save you from your sin and made Him the leader of your life?
7. How can you celebrate Jesus, the true meaning of Christmas, this season?

Lesson 4

1. What was Jesus doing when Peter and his friends were washing their fishing nets? (He was teaching the Word of God to a crowd of people)
2. What little thing did Jesus ask Simon Peter to do? (Put the boat out from shore so Jesus could continue to teach the people)
3. What did Jesus ask Simon Peter to do that didn't make sense? (Put the boat out in the deep water during the day and let the nets down to catch fish)
4. Did Simon Peter obey Jesus? (Yes)
5. What happened when Simon Peter and his friends let the nets down into the deep water? (They caught so many fish the two boats began to sink)
6. What did Jesus ask Simon Peter and his friends to do after they had caught so many fish? (Follow Him to go catch men)
7. What did Simon Peter and his friends do? (They followed Jesus and became His servants)
8. What is Jesus asking you to do as you follow Him? Will you do it?

Lesson 5

1. Where did Jesus, His disciples, and His mother go? (They went to a wedding in Cana)
2. What was the problem at the wedding? (They ran out of wine)
3. What did Jesus' mother do when she found out they had run out of wine? (She told Jesus about it)
4. What did Jesus do? (He told the servants to fill up the hand-washing pots to the brim with water and take some to the master of the banquet; the water turned into wine)
5. What did the master of the banquet say about the wine? (It was the best)
6. When Jesus turned the water into wine, it was His very first miracle. Has Jesus done any miracles in your life? What?

Lesson 6

1. Who was Nicodemus? (Nicodemus was a Jewish religious leader and teacher; he was also a Pharisee)
2. True or False: Nicodemus believed that Jesus was sent by God. (True)
3. Why did Nicodemus go to see Jesus? (Nicodemus wanted to know how people can have eternal life in heaven, the Kingdom of God)
4. What did Jesus say was the only way people can enter heaven? (People must be born again)
5. What does being born again mean? (It means that you believe in Jesus to save you from your sin, then you're born into God's family, and you become a new person)
6. Why do some people not believe in Jesus to save them from their sins? (They choose their way - sin, instead of choosing God's way - obeying Him)
7. Have you been born again? If you have, what can you feel like? (A new person who is in God's family)

Lesson 7

1. Who is the Good Shepherd? (Jesus)
2. Who are the Good Shepherd's sheep? (The people who believe in Jesus to save them from their sin)
3. Who are the sheep that don't belong to the Good Shepherd? (The people who don't believe in Jesus to save them from their sin)
4. When Jesus saves you from your sin, is it just the sins you've done in the past? (No, He forgives all of our sins - past, present, and future)
5. What does the Good Shepherd give His sheep? (Eternal life)
6. How long is eternal life? (Forever)
7. Can anyone or anything ever take you out of God's family? (No) What is this called? (Eternal security)
8. Do you have eternal life and eternal security?

Lesson 8

1. Where did Jesus stop to rest when He was on His way to Galilee? (He stopped at Jacob's well in Samaria)
2. Who came to the well when Jesus was there? (A Samaritan woman)
3. Why was she surprised Jesus asked her for a drink of water? (1. The Jews didn't like the Samaritans because they had disobeyed God and married their enemies, and 2. Men and women who didn't know each other weren't supposed to speak to each other in public)
4. What kind of water did Jesus tell the woman He could give? (Living water)
5. What did Jesus mean when He talked about living water? (The grace, love, joy, hope, and eternal life that comes from trusting Jesus as Savior and Lord)
6. What did the Samaritan woman do when she believed Jesus? (She went to tell other Samaritans about Him)
7. What happened after the woman told others about Jesus? (Many believed in Jesus and were saved)
8. Who have you told about Jesus? Why or why not?

Lesson 9

1. Why did Jesus say the man was born blind? (So people could see God at work in his life)
2. What did Jesus do to heal the blind man? (He made mud out of dirt and His spit and put it on the man's eyes)
3. What did the man have to do to be healed? (He had to obey Jesus and go to the pool to wash the mud off)
4. Were the Pharisees happy Jesus healed the blind man? (No, at first they didn't believe it, and then they called Jesus a sinner because He healed the blind man on the Sabbath Day)
5. What did the Pharisees do when the man said Jesus was sent by God? (They kicked him out of the synagogue)
6. What did the man do when Jesus came to Him the second time? (He believed in Jesus to be saved from his sin, and he worshiped Him)
7. What special plan does God have for your life?

Lesson 10

1. What example of prayer did Jesus give us? (Jesus began His day spending time alone talking with His Father)
2. How can we be sure God hears us when we talk with Him? (If we have become part of God's family by trusting in Jesus, God always hears us) *Read John 14:6*
3. When should we pray? (The first thing every day and then all throughout the day)
4. Should we ask for what we want or for what God wants for us? (What God wants for us)
5. For whom should we pray? (Ourselves and others)
6. How does God answer our prayers? (Yes, no, or wait)
7. What should we do about our sins when we talk with God? (We should admit, confess, and repent of our sins; we should also ask Him to help us to not sin)

Prayer

Purpose: To emphasize important truths about prayer.

Sample questions:

- Does God hear you when you pray? (Yes!)
- Name one thing you prayed for this week.
- When and where can you pray? (Anytime and anywhere)
- How does God answer prayers? (Yes, No, Wait)
- After you become a Christian, what should you do when you sin? (Admit, confess, repent)

Worship / Names of God

Purpose: To challenge students to think about their God and worship only Him.

Sample questions:

- Fill in the blank: My God is _____. (Strong, loving, wise, creative, all-knowing, all-powerful, perfect, dependable, awesome)
- Fill in the blank: My God is called _____. (Father, Lord, Counselor, Prince of Peace, Creator, Savior, King)

Optional: Create a wall of names that you could use as a focus point during worship.

Wordless Book – Using the verses

Purpose: To connect Wordless Book verses with Gospel points.

Sample questions:

- What verse reminds us to grow spiritually? (2 Peter 3:18a)
- Recite this verse. (Students should recite the full verse – 2 Peter 3:18a: But grow in the grace and knowledge of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ)
- What verse teaches us that we have all sinned? (Romans 3:23)
- Recite this verse. (Students should recite the full verse – Romans 3:23: For all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God.)

Advanced sample questions:

- A friend tells you that they are perfect; what Wordless color pops into your head and what verse would you use? (Dark, Romans 3:23)
- A relative tells you that heaven is not real; what Wordless Book color pops into your head and what verse would you use? (Gold, John 14:2)

Top 12 – Finish the verse

Purpose: To challenge students to confidently know the verse by listening to the first half and completing the second half of the verse.

Leaders give the reference and the first half of the verse and students will answer with the second half.

6. 2 Peter 3:18a: But grow in the grace _____. (and knowledge of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ)
7. John 14:6: Jesus answered, "I am _____. (the way and the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me)
8. Hebrews 9:22b: ...and without the _____. (shedding of blood there is no forgiveness)
9. Acts 16:31: Believe in the Lord Jesus, _____. (and you will be saved – you and your household)
10. Ephesians 2:8-9: For it is by grace we have been saved, _____. (through faith – and this not from yourselves, it is the gift of God – not by works, so that no one can boast)

Pre-Service Review Game

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Option 1: Let's have a blast!

Big Idea: Students will earn foam finger shooters to shoot through hoops to score points for their team based on a multiple-choice question. The team with the most points wins. The goal of the game is for students to read and study their Tracker's Treasures at home. *Questions for this game will be based on Tracker's Treasures from previous weeks. All questions are fair game, including those from missions, riddles, the Think, Feel, and Do Right sections, and review questions from the Know Right section.*

Supplies:

- Cones (one per team)
- Lines for teams to sit/rotate on (painter's tape or Velcro)
- Hula hoops or rings hanging from the ceiling
- 10 or more foam finger shooters
- 1 set of 3 paddles with the letters A, B, C for each team participating
- Large fun whiteboard/scoreboard with bright Christmas lights attached



Instructions:

1. Divide students into teams by grade/gender/random. Place cones to indicate the different teams and have students sit in a row vertically behind the cone facing the emcee or stage.
2. The emcee of the game will ask a multiple-choice question (answers should be A, B, or C) to the first student in each line. The emcee will count to three and the students all have to grab the A, B, or C paddle at the same time (this will eliminate cheating).
3. All students should select a letter and raise it over their head. The students who answer correctly will immediately get a foam finger shooter and quickly attempt to shoot it through a hoop (10 seconds or less). The hoop should be at least 5-10 feet away from students answering questions.
4. Each foam finger shooter that makes it through the hoop earns 5 points for their team.
5. An assistant to the emcee should run and grab the foam finger shooters as students continue with #6.
6. The emcee should then yell, "Rotate!" Students should then rotate. The first student will run to the back of the line and the remaining students will shuffle forward. First team to be sitting quietly will gain a point. This should be a fun and fast event!
7. Repeat, starting from #2 until time is up, then announce the winning team.

Special Tips:

- As you're hanging the hoops, test the height and distance to make sure it's achievable.
- Do not let students play with the finger shooters prior to the game. They should earn a chance to shoot.
- As you conclude the game, encourage students to read their Tracker's Treasures at home so they are ready for next week.
- Create a competition for Tracker's Treasures' coupons this quarter. The team with the most signed coupons at the end of the month will get a celebration such as a donut party.
- To help students practice shooting with accuracy, have foam finger shooters for sale in your Discover Market.
- Optional: Occasionally yell out a bonus question to students in line who are waiting for their turn. This should help keep students engaged in the game. (Give points only, not foam finger shooters.)
- We recommend purchasing quality foam finger shooters for this game. They will last longer and shoot straighter (fingermissiles.com)

Option 2: Wheel of Questions!

Big Idea: Students will spin a big wheel to determine what kind of question they will answer to earn points for their team. The goal of the game is for students to read and study their Tracker's Treasures at home. *Questions for this game will be based on Tracker's Treasures from previous weeks. All questions are fair game, including those from missions, riddles, the Think, Feel, and Do Right sections, and review questions from the Know Right section.*

Supplies:

- Large "Wheel of Questions" wheel that stands up and is visually divided into "slices"
- Large fun whiteboard/scoreboard with bright Christmas lights attached
- Bells or multiple fun sound effects

Each slice of the wheel should have an option listed, such as:

- Know Right = 20 Points
- Think Right = 10 Points
- Do Right = 15 points
- Feel Right = 20 Points
- Around the World! = 30 Points
- Riddles and Jokes = 5 Points
- Lose a Turn = 0
- Smile = Extra 100 points
- High Five! = 5 Points



Instructions:

1. Divide students into teams by grade/gender/random.
2. Have a student from the first team spin the wheel. That student will get a question based on the topic they spun. *If they give the correct answer, have a fun sound-effect ring out while the score is being recorded on the whiteboard.*
3. Continue with the next team.
4. The team with the highest score wins.

Special Tips:

- As you conclude the game, encourage students to read their Tracker's Treasures at home so they are ready for the next week.
- Create a competition for Tracker's Treasures' coupons this quarter. The team with the most signed coupons at the end of the month will get a celebration such as a donut party.
- Turn the questions into true/false, multiple choice and fill-in-the-blank questions to keep the game moving quickly.

Bonus Mission Lessons

An option for classes that visit the Mission Station twice

Option A: Around the World Challenge

Supplies:

- World maps or globes (one per team)
- Magnetic shapes and/or letters
- Magnetic wall*
- Tracker Tickets or a treat from around the world (for the winning team)

*Alternate ideas if you don't have a magnetic wall:

- Have teams use magnetic letters or shapes to write the names on the floor or on tables (directly on the floor or tables, or on poster boards or roll paper).
- Have teams use toothpicks or popsicle sticks to write the names on the floor or on tables (directly on the floor or tables, or on poster boards or roll paper).
- Have teams create a poster on a large poster board with John 3:16 and names of countries from around the world. Award Tracker Tickets or treats to either the team with the most creative poster or the poster with the most countries listed. (Decide the criteria for the winning team in advance.)



Instructions:

1. Divide students into teams.
2. Give each team a world map.
3. Say: Can you guess how many countries there are around the world? (About 200; *give three Tracker Tickets for the closest guess*) Did you know God loves every single person and knows the number of hairs on each of their heads? He loves them so much that He sent His one and only Son to die for them. How do we know this? (John 3:16 and Matthew 10:30; *give three Tracker Tickets if students answer correctly*) This means no matter where you go on this earth, Jesus died for those people. The question is, has every person heard the Good News of Jesus? Let's stop and think about the countries around the world. To do this, we are going to do the "Around the World Challenge." Your goal, as a team, is to write as many names as possible of different countries using magnet shapes and/or letters in 8 minutes. (Hint: Students may want to look for countries with short names)
4. Team with the most countries will win three Tracker Tickets each or a treat from around the world.
5. After the winning team is announced, have students stop and pick a country to pray for. Pray that God will protect the Christians in that country and that the Gospel will be proclaimed clearly to all the people.

Option B: Around the World Challenge

Print a copy of country flags from around the world for each team.

Using magnetic shapes, have teams try to create as many flags as possible using the correct colors.

Bulletin Boards

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Celebrate Jesus!

- Cover the board in colorful paper to create a fun celebration theme. Add squares of tissue paper to look like confetti.
- Create the words “Celebrate Jesus!” on the board in large letters (optional: make 3D letters by covering foam letters in aluminum foil)
- Include five brightly colored envelopes down the side of the bulletin board with a Tracker Ticket in each envelope (put a different denomination in each envelope - 1, 2, 3, 5 or 10)
- Award a quiet seat prize winner of the day and allow them to select a Tracker Ticket out of one of the envelopes.
- Option: instead of awarding a quiet seat prize winner, ask five review questions. As each is answered, let the student choose a Tracker Ticket from one of the envelopes.
- Remember to restock and rearrange the tickets each week before class.

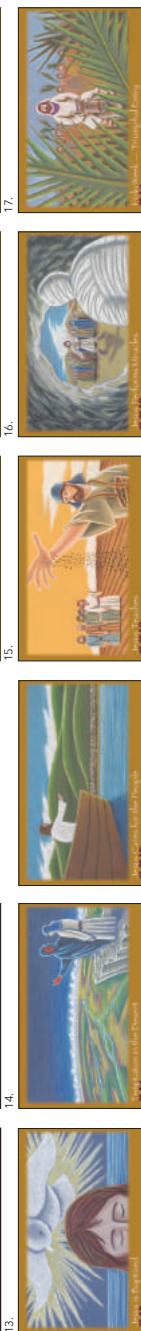

Topical Lesson: Celebrate Jesus! (Worship Leader’s choice)			

Worship Plan: K-2nd

Note: Close Worship Time with prayer before dismissing to Discover Time.

Lesson 1

Transition 1: What is God like? *Let kids shout out attributes.* God will always be these things; He will never change. We can confidently (*stand in a “superhero stance”: hands on hips, chin up, confident*) live for God every day!

Song 1: “We Will Live”

Transition 2: I want to teach you a new song today called “Tell the World.” I want you to focus on the words and what they say about who Jesus is. Let’s practice the chorus together. *Say the words, do the motions, and then have kids repeat them back to you.* This might be a new song, but we are gonna sing it with everything God gave us! Let’s do a boys vs. girls worship sing off. Who can give Jesus the most glory in this song? Boys? *Have boys cheer.* Or Girls? *Have them cheer, and then start the song.*

Song 2: “Tell the World”

Transition 3: Let’s pray before we finish. Jesus, we lift up our hands to You in worship.

Song 3: “Unchanging”

Lesson 2

Transition 1: If I said, “Everyone line up to get a cookie!”, how eager would you be to get in line? What if I said, “Line up to help make the cookies so they can be used to share Jesus with a group of kids”? How eager are you now? Serving Jesus is an AWESOME thing, and the reward is SO much better than any cookie could be! In fact, serving Jesus is so awesome we should never ever stop serving Him!

Song 1: “Don’t Ever Stop”

Transition 2: Who remembers the worship song we sang last week? It’s called “Tell the ... World”! You know a great way to do that? By confidently serving Jesus! See all the Teachers, DT Leaders, and Shepherds here? They are ALL eager to serve Jesus by teaching you all about God’s Word! Then you need to take everything you’ve learned and serve Jesus by telling the world about Him!

Song 2: “Tell the World”

Transition 3: *Pray.* Lord, we want to humbly serve You and tell others of Your great love. Jesus, there is no other name worthy of our worship. *Song should start as you say “Amen”.*

Song 3: “No Other Name”

Lesson 3

Transition 1: Are you sitting down?! We’ve gotta get up, friends! We need to tell the world about Jesus! Some people haven’t heard about God’s amazing love. Are you ready to get up and sing it out for the whole world to hear? *Have students crouch down ready to jump up on 1-2-3 and yell “Jesus!” The song should start on 3.*

Song 1: “Get Up, Get Up”

Transition 2: Our God is an amazing, holy, loving God! God’s love for you is so awesome that He sent His one and only Son, Jesus, to rescue you from your sin! The amazing part is, it’s FREE! God’s Word tells us in Acts 16:31 how we can be saved and believe in the Lord Jesus. If you believe and know Jesus is the one and only true God, yell, “AMEN!”

Song 2: “I Believe in Jesus”

Transition 3: Our hearts should rejoice in God’s love and in the hope He gives us. Let’s humbly kneel down and worship our awesome God.

Song 3: “Psalm 33”

Lesson 4

Transition 1: Remember when we talked about being eager to serve Jesus? Jesus had 12 disciples who were eager to serve and follow Him! And they boldly told the world about Jesus! Can you be disciples who follow and live for Jesus, too? YES! If you are ready to follow Jesus, on the count of three yell out “JESUS!” 1, 2, (*song starts*) 3!

Song 1: “We Will Live”

Transition 2: Friends, I want to boldly follow Jesus just like His disciples did. We need to get up and get out and tell the whole world about God’s amazing love!

Song 2: “Get Up, Get Up”

Transition 3: We are going to pray. Jesus, I have a simple prayer; help me to follow You. Jesus, You alone are worthy of my worship. Help me to worship You with all my heart. In Jesus’ name, Amen.

Song 3: “No Other Name”

Lesson 5

Transition 1: It's a miracle! Who's heard that before? Does God still do miracles? YES! The question is: are we giving God the glory for the miracles? I hear people say "Wow, that was cool!" or "I wonder how that happened?" Friends, that's our chance to give God the glory! You get to say "that was God!" They might think you're crazy...because we are crazy committed to Jesus! Let's yell "Jesus!" on three. *Get down ready to jump on three. 1, 2, (song starts) 3!*

Song 1: "I Believe in Jesus"

Transition 2: You are crazy about Jesus. I love it! But are we bold enough to tell the whole world about Jesus and His miracles? Let's see who is all in for Jesus! Boys shout out (*have them ready to do fist pump motion*) "Tell the World". Girls shout out (*have them ready to do fist pump motion*) "Your name is Jesus". *Have them go back and forth a few times and then start the song.*

Song 2: "Tell the World"

Transition 3: Let's pray. Jesus, we are amazed and in awe of the miracles we see You do all around us! We want to point others to You, always giving You glory and honor. Jesus, help us to worship You now with everything we've got. *Start song.* In Jesus' name, Amen.

Song 3: "Unchanging"

Lesson 6

Transition 1: "Born again..." What does that mean? It means **you** have prayed and admitted you are a sinner, asked Jesus to forgive your sins, and to be the leader of your life. This is the greatest decision you could ever make! Friends, there is only one true God, and He is Jesus! There is power in His name. Let's shout out "JESUS!" on three! 1, 2, 3, (*song starts*) JESUS!

Song 1: "I Believe in Jesus"

Transition 2: Declaring that you believe in Jesus to save you from your sin, to be the leader of your life - that is being born again! Let's sing our worship song "Only Jesus". I want this song and these words to be sung with our whole hearts to Jesus.

Song 2: "Only Jesus"

Transition 3: Jesus, only Jesus.

Song 3: "Unchanging"

Lesson 7

Transition 1: *On a white board, using a dry erase marker, draw a straight line. Erase it and draw it again. Keep erasing and drawing. While drawing and erasing say:* I know all I have to do is draw a line and be done, but I don't feel confident that my line is straight enough. I feel like I should keep doing it again so that I get it just right. Sometimes we feel this way after we've prayed and asked Jesus to be the leader of our life. So we ask Jesus over and over again to be our leader. But we can be secure - know for sure - that the first time we pray Jesus hears us, forgives, and is always with us! Knowing we are secure helps us go out and live for Jesus!

Song 1: "We Will Live"

Transition 2: Only Jesus! Who remembers the song we sang last week and can sing it out to Jesus with 110%, boys or girls?

Song 2: "Only Jesus"

Transition 3: *Quietly bow down to your knees, fold your hands, and begin to pray. Kids should follow.* Jesus, we worship You now, knowing we can be secure in You. Secure - 100% sure - that in You, Jesus, there is forgiveness and eternal life. *Song begins.* In Jesus' name, Amen.

Song 3: "Psalm 33"

Lesson 8

Transition 1: We need to (*get ready to do hand motion*) "Tell the World" that Your name is JESUS! Now just boys! Now just girls! All together!

Song 1: "Tell the World"

Transition 2: Jesus is the one true Savior and it's our job, our privilege, to tell the whole world about Him! Jesus, You are the way - the only way - and we don't ever wanna stop telling the world about You!

Song 2: "Don't Ever Stop"

Transition 3: Jesus, You are the one true Savior. In Jesus' name, Amen.

Song 3: "Only Jesus"

Lesson 9

Transition 1: Have you ever wondered, "Does God have a plan for me?" YES, He does! Just like Proverbs 3:5-6 says, God wants you to choose to trust Him, lean on Him, and to never, ever stop following Him!

Song 1: "Don't Ever Stop"

Transition 2: Our verse today reminds me that God has a lot of **"always"** attached to Him.

Hmmm...what does that mean? God **always** has a plan for my life. I can **always** trust God's plan. God is **always** with me. So I should **always** be praising God!

Song 2: "Always With Us"

Transition 3: (*Kneel down*) Jesus, help each of us to not lean on our own understanding and do it our way. Help us to obey all Your Word says and trust in Your plans for us. Help us to praise You and to worship You every day. In Jesus' name, Amen.

Song 3: "Psalm 33"

Lesson 10

Transition 1: Did you know we have a direct line to God? It's called prayer! I can pray wherever I am - school, the bus, at home, anywhere! I can talk to God when I am scared, sad, happy, or excited. Jesus is always with us!

Song 1: "Always With Us"

Transition 2: Prayer isn't just me asking for a bunch of stuff I want. Prayer is thanking God for who He is and worshiping Him. We can and should pray for courage and strength to obey His Word. See friends, I want to go wherever God says to go, and I want to be God's hands and feet! I want to live for Him!

Song 2: "Get Up, Get Up"

Transition 3: Rejoice...what does that mean? It means to be overjoyed by God's grace. As we worship and sing these words to God, let our hearts rejoice in God's grace and love.

Song 3: "Only Jesus"

Lesson 11

Transition 1: We have learned so much about Jesus these last 12 weeks! We don't want to keep God's Word to ourselves! We need to go out and share it with everyone we know, and tell them that Jesus is the way, the truth, and the life! Don't ever stop worshiping Jesus!

Song 1: "Don't Ever Stop"

Transition 2: I want to go wherever God says to go! I want to see the way God sees! I want to do all things for God's glory!

Song 2: "We Will Live"

Transition 3: We are going to pause a minute and remember all we have learned in God's Word (*bow head, stand silent for 30 seconds*). Let's worship Him now for all He's done and all He will do.

Song 3: "Unchanging"

Lesson 12

Transition 1: Are you ready to worship God with everything you've got? Shout it back to me: "We will tell the world, Your name is Jesus!" (*assistants and kids repeat*) Now just the boys! Just the girls! You said you were ready to worship with everything you've got! Let me hear it all together! (*song starts on Jesus*)

Song 1: "Tell the World"

Transition 2: We can boldly go out and tell the whole world because of all we have learned about who God is! He is Power, He is Hope, He is King, and He is always - always - with us!

Song 2: “Always With Us”

Transition 3: Who is able to forgive? (Only Jesus) Who is our righteousness? (Only Jesus) Who has the greatest love? (Only Jesus) Jesus, only You are worthy of worship.

Song 3: “Only Jesus”

Worship Plan: 3rd-5th

Note: Close Worship Time with prayer before dismissing to Discover Time.

Lesson 1

Transition 1: What would you say if I told you that there was actually one thing that is impossible for God? I bet you would say that you don’t believe me. But... there is one thing that is impossible. It is impossible for God to change! That’s great news because it means that God remains as strong today as He was 3000 years ago. He’s not weaker because of what He has already done, and He’s not exhausted from creating the world either. That means there is nothing that is impossible for Him to do, because He has not changed!

Song 1: “Nothing is Impossible”

Transition 2: One other thing that has never and will never change about God is that there is still only one way that He intends for us to know Him, and it is through His Son, Jesus Christ. Jesus is the one way to

heaven. In the book of Hebrews, we learn that if we want to know God, we need to study and know who Jesus is, because Jesus is the exact representation of God. We need to look to the Son for salvation and to grow closer to God. Jesus is always the answer!

Song 2: “Look to the Son”

Transition 3: Given who He is, I think we can agree that there is no one higher than our God! He is perfect and His plan is perfect. Let's remember that He is the highest authority in heaven and on earth!

Song 3: “No One Higher”

Lesson 2

Transition 1: If your favorite sports star, musician, or actor were to suddenly show up at your door, would you invite them in for dinner? You bet you would! And if they sat down, would you offer to get them something to drink? If they asked for a second helping at the table, you would probably jump out of your chair to serve them. Why? Because of what they did for you? Nope - they didn't do anything for you. It would be simply because of who they are. That's how God wants us to serve Him, too. He wants us to give our lives to Him because of who He is. We should be more excited to give our lives to Him, than we would be to an earthly 'hero'.

Song 1: “Get to Give”

Transition 2: When we talk about serving God because of who He is, we need to remember that everything you see, everything you smell, everything you touch, everything you hear is because of Him. He has literally created every good thing! We have a song to do today by that same title and it reminds us that we can take credit for nothing because God is the author of all. We can sometimes take Him and the life that He's given us for granted. We need to slow down and remember that He is the giver of every good gift!

Song 2: “Every Good Thing”

Transition 3: Let's not stop thinking about who our God is. Join me as we sing another song about God's amazing qualities!!

Song 3: “Raise a Hallelujah”

Lesson 3

Transition 1: How many of you have ever watched your parents use Google maps and get lost? Or asked Siri for directions and they weren't right? Those devices are only as good as the people who program them. If there is road construction, then they have to update the app as soon as possible, otherwise they will give the wrong information. When it comes to being a part of God's Kingdom and being in heaven with Him someday, there is only one source for the information we need. That source is the Bible, and the Bible tells us that Jesus is the only way to heaven. We need to look to the Son to be saved!

Song 1: “Look to the Son”

Transition 2: Let's say that your best friend is going to meet you somewhere and you just realized that Google maps or Siri gave you the wrong directions when you were on your way. Would you call your friend to tell them? Why? Because you want them to join you where you are, and you want to warn them that they may also have bad directions! That's what friends do! So many people think they have the right directions to heaven, but when Jesus comes back, they will realize that they didn't. If we love them, we need to tell them that they have the wrong directions (in a gentle and respectful manner) so they don't find themselves at the wrong place when they die! We need to let it be known to everyone!

Song 2: “Let it be Known”

Transition 3: The world that we live in today says that there are many ways to get to heaven. We need to let it be known that there is no other name besides Jesus that can save them!

Song 3: “No Other Name”

Lesson 4

Transition 1: I remember when my kids were little, and I left them with a babysitter. That babysitter used to leave a trail of sugary treats for them around the house for them to follow. It was just a 'fun' thing for them to do, I guess. My kids, because they were little and trusting (and because the treats were good!), would have followed that trail anywhere! Jesus has a trail for us to follow as well. Sometimes the trail is an easy one to follow, and sometimes it might feel like He is taking us out into the middle of a storm. If we keep our eyes on Him, and not on the distractions around us, we can do amazing things. The disciple Peter actually walked on waves because he kept his eyes on Jesus. I don't know about you, but I want to be a wave walker, too!

Song 1: “WaveWalker”

Transition 2: Even if we do not know where the trail leads, we can be sure that because of who is leading us, the things that seem hard now will eventually be good. After all, will you get bigger muscles by lifting easy weights or hard weights? It's through the struggle that we grow. That means that not only the obviously good blessings are from God, but the hard things are from Him, too, and are designed to help us grow. Let's remember that every good thing is from God!

Song 2: “Every Good Thing”

Transition 3: Based on who He is and what He has done, let's stand in awe of God who does GREAT THINGS!

Song 3: “Great Things”**Lesson 5**

Transition 1: What makes it impossible for me to lift this building with my pinkie finger? *Allow for answers.* What makes it impossible for me to give you a million dollars? *Allow for answers.* What makes it impossible for me to be in 100 places at one time? *Allow for answers.* What makes it impossible for me to forgive all of your sin and make you right with God? (All sin is against God so He's the only one who can forgive sin) Based on who I am, I can't do hardly anything. But... based on who God is, there is nothing that is impossible for Him, including forgiving our sins!

Song 1: “Nothing is Impossible”

Transition 2: When you admit that you have sinned against and ignored the holy Creator, God, and ask Him to take the punishment for the sins that you have done and give them to Jesus, Jesus' death on the cross then covers your sins - once for all. At that moment, you become God's child. Having God as a Father and knowing that there is nothing that is impossible for Him should move me to take even more risks for the Kingdom. I have my Father's protection and His faithfulness, what more do I need? Let's move our feet and start doing Kingdom work for the Father that is worthy!

Song 2: “Movin' Me”

Transition 3: God needs nothing from us. He could do all the work Himself, but He is so generous that He allows us to partner with Him in the work that He has for the Kingdom. Let's take a minute and remember who our God is!!

Song 3: “Raise a Hallelujah”**Lesson 6**

Transition 1: *You (Person 1) will need a coat and another person (Person 2) to join you on stage who will fit into the coat.*

Person 1: *Hold up the coat.*

Person 2: Hey, that coat looks like it will fit me.

Person 1: It's a size _____ (*insert the size*).

Person 2: That's my size!! I know it will fit me!

Person 1: *Give the coat to Person 2.*

Person 2: *Put the coat on.* It's a perfect fit!!

This is how salvation works. You hear the truth, then you agree with the facts of the truth, and then you own it! You hear about Jesus, you realize that the facts line up and that you need Him to forgive your sin, and then you own it by looking to the Son to save you from your sin.

Song 1: “Look to the Son”

Transition 2: There was a woman who had a husband who made a cleaning list of things for her to do around the house every day. If she didn't complete the things on the list, he would hit her and be very mean to her. That man died, and the woman remarried. The new husband was very kind to her. One day she was cleaning her house and found a list of things that her first husband left for her. In shock, she realized that she had already completed all the things on that list that very day! What she could not complete out of fear, she had no problem completing out of love! That's what God wants from us - He wants us to give Him our lives to use out of a heart of love. What an honor that we get to give our lives to Him!!

Song 2: “Get to Give”

Transition 3: It's important that we see who God really is. If He is perfect (and He is), then the fact that He made us the way He did on purpose will make us realize that He did not make any mistakes when He created us. There might be things we don't like about ourselves or that we want to change, but when we see that God says we are special because we are His, then we can accept those things. It's all about who He

says we are - not what the world says!

Song 3: "Who You Say I Am"

Lesson 7

Transition 1: If I offered you a broken package of Oreo cookies or a package full of perfect Oreo cookies with no breaks in ANY of the cookies, which one would you take? You would always take the perfect one because it is seen as the better gift! God is perfect, and that means that the best gift that He could possibly give us is Himself!! But not only does He give us Himself, He also gives us so many more good gifts every day! Just think - the sunshine, good food (I mean, He could have made it tasteless), a world that is 3D instead of flat like a cartoon...the list goes on and on. Let's remember that every good thing comes from God!

Song 1: "Every Good Thing"

Transition 2: When we talk about God being the perfect gift, we should be reminded of the Trinity. God the Father is 100% God, and He created everything. God the Son, Jesus, is 100% God. He took our sins upon Himself for anyone who confesses their sinfulness and asks Him to take them. And God the Holy Spirit is 100% God and is God's gift of Himself to us. When you become a believer, the Holy Spirit comes to live inside you as your all time, perfect guide. He helps you make decisions, say 'no' to sin, and He carries your burdens. Really...He makes you more alive than you've ever been before!!

Song 2: "Alive"

Transition 3: There really is only one response to the perfect gift God has given us. We need to remember all the GREAT things He's done and praise Him for who He is!

Song 3: "Great Things"

Lesson 8

Transition 1: If you had one Oreo, how hard would it be to share it? If you had one million Oreos, how hard would it be to share one? When we see how much God has given us in His forgiveness, love, and grace, we should be able to easily share that with anyone who has wronged us, anyone who needs love, and anyone who makes a mistake and needs us to give them grace. Knowing how deep God's gift to us is, it should move us to share some of that gift with anyone who needs it!

Song 1: "Movin' Me"

Transition 2: There are over 4200 religions in the world. Could you guys name all 4200? No way! Could you tell me the difference between them all? What would you say if I said, "Yes, you can!!" There are two major differences between all the world religions. Christianity is the only religion that says that salvation is DONE in Christ for anyone who understands they have sinned against a Holy God and asks Him to forgive them. Every other religion is a DO religion where you have to DO certain things to get to heaven. The other difference is that Christianity recognizes that Jesus isn't just a good teacher, He IS God. That's important because that means that He can forgive the sins committed against God. We need to be moved by God to let those truths be known to the rest of the world!!

Song 2: "Let it be Known"

Transition 3: I think we need to remind ourselves who God is!! Let's raise a song of praise to our great King!

Song 3: "Raise a Hallelujah"

Lesson 9

Transition 1: If you knew you were going to make a mistake later today, would you do something different now to avoid making it? I bet you would. We would love to know what the future holds, but faith isn't knowing what the future holds. It IS knowing who holds the future. That is why we continue to study who God is and what He has done, so that when the future looks scary and we aren't sure what God's plan is, we can remember that nothing is impossible for Him!

Song 1: "Nothing is Impossible"

Transition 2: If we continue to remember that nothing is impossible for God, then we will also realize that we can take as many risks for the Kingdom as we want because there are no risky situations for God - He always knows the outcome! Now when we see that He wants to use our lives for His glory and to advance His kingdom, we will consider it an honor and be more at ease giving our lives to Him for service.

Song 2: "Get to Give"

Transition 3: This is the amazing generosity of God. Not only does He save us, but then He also says that

the more time we spend with Him, the more we will see that He made us just the way He wants us. When we see that, we will see that it also means that He can use us in a way He can use no one else. Let's embrace who God says we are so that we can be used to the fullest for Him!

Song 3: "Who You Say I Am"

Lesson 10

Transition 1: I need you guys to shout out some of the good things in your life!! *Allow for about 1-2 minutes of them shouting out good things.* Another good thing He has given us is the ability to talk directly to Him in prayer. We can enjoy the gift too much and forget the giver OR we can just assume the good gift will always be there and forget that God continues to allow that gift in our lives. Let's not forget to remember where all those good things came from.

Song 1: "Every Good Thing"

Transition 2: I think the best gift God has ever given us is Himself. Over and over in Scripture we read that when we are saved, He gives us the Holy Spirit - Himself. And when we obey His commands, He gives us more understanding of Himself. Many world religions do not believe that God hears and answers our prayers, but as Christians we can feel more alive than ever when we pray and God answers. That's when we are sure that we have access to God in ways many people wish they had, but don't. Let's celebrate that God makes us more alive when He saves us and teaches us!!

Song 2: "Alive"

Transition 3: As much as there are humans that have done incredible things, there is not one human who could stop storms, heal diseases in everyone, raise the dead, and literally save the entire world in one act. When Jesus died on the cross, that's exactly what He did. He offered salvation to the world. Let's take a minute to sing about the fact that there is no one higher!

Song 3: "No One Higher"

Lesson 11

Transition 1: Today is review day! When we are reviewing what we've learned this quarter, it should really move us to do things that are God-sized. In order to do that, we need to remember what we've learned in God's Word. His character, who He is, what He's done, and the promises that He's made. Those truths should move us to be different from the world and become magnets for the kingdom!!

Song 1: "Movin' Me"

Transition 2: One way that we can let the world know who Jesus is and what He has done is to SHOW them. When God moves us to love like Jesus, forgive like Jesus, and give grace like Jesus, the world will wonder what it is that makes us able to do that. When they see that we also have peace about that - 1 Peter says it should cause them to ask us where we get our hope from. The Bible says that people should be asking, and when they do, we can tell them about Jesus and let it be known to all who He is and what He has offered to them!

Song 2: "Let it be Known"

Transition 2: Let's take a stand now and worship the one true King for His unchanging character and His GREAT deeds!

Song 3: "Great Things"

Lesson 12

Transition 1: *Ask students some questions about things that are their favorite.* What's your favorite food? Favorite animal? Favorite color? What's your favorite present you've ever gotten? When we think of all the good things that are in our lives, we need to always remember that anything that is good has to come from the source of "good". God is good. I don't mean "good" as compared to something else. He is the source of good. That means that every good thing we have comes from Him!!

Song 1: "Every Good Thing"

Transition 2: Not only does God provide us with good things that we can enjoy, but the Bible says that when we give our lives to Him, the treasure of salvation does not end there. God also gives us the power over sin. To have power over sin is like being a wave walker; sometimes it feels impossible to resist the temptation to sin. But God tells us in 1 Corinthians 10:13 that when we are tempted, He will not allow us to be tempted beyond what we can handle, and He will always provide a way out. Let's take a minute to sing about the

God that made us wave walkers - able to conquer the seemingly impossible task of power over sin!

Song 2: “WaveWalker”

Transition 3: We’re going to end the quarter with a song that remembers who God is and what He’s done. Let’s raise our hands and voices in praise!! Hallelujah means to praise joyfully – let’s do that and raise a hallelujah!

Song 3: “Raise a Hallelujah”

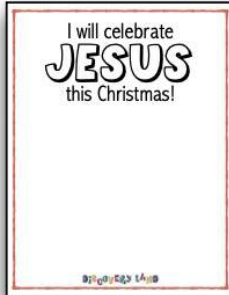

- Each student should have a Bible, the test answer sheets, a piece of construction paper to guide them on their answer sheet, and a pencil.

Visitors:

- Visiting students should not take the test. Alternate ideas for these students are listed in the curriculum.

Test Instructions:

- The Lead Teacher should not facilitate the test for their own class. The Director or a different Lead Teacher could fulfill this role instead. The facilitator should know the material, be able to ask questions at a K-1st grade level, and be able to rephrase questions as needed to help students understand the questions.
- Make sure students clearly write their first and last names on their answer sheet, since they might be given to parents. As an alternative, class percentage results on topics could be sent home.
- The questions are designed as multiple choice questions with clear picture choices. Have students place their piece of construction paper under the question on their answer sheet as you read it to students. Then, instruct them to circle the correct answer. You may want to demonstrate this. Students should slide down their construction paper as the questions are being asked.
- The facilitator should ask questions and the Shepherd(s) and DT Leader should help keep students on the correct question. Please do not give students the answers. It may be helpful for the facilitator to have a copy of the Answer Sheet for reference while reading the questions.
- Scoring: All incorrect answers should be circled so leaders and parents can see how their students did. If your church is using numerical scoring, give one point for each correct answer. At the top of page 1 on the student's Answer Sheet, note the total number of correct answers out of a possible 25. If a percentage score is desired, multiply the student's total number of points earned by 100; then divide by the number of total points possible.
